German Classes for Children

The German Saturday School of Austin offers fun and engaging language instruction for kids. These classes, designed for children ages 3-13, meet Saturday mornings in downtown Austin. Two 12-week sessions are offered each year, beginning in January (winter session) and September (fall session), along with shorter summer sessions. Both fall and winter semester classes run Saturdays from 9:30 to 11:30 am.

Our teaching staff consists of native German speakers experienced in tutoring children and German teachers from local public schools. Lessons focus on comprehension and speaking for all age groups. Instructors use art, music, and games as well as traditional learning methods. Our older Mittelschule students (ages 9-13) will use textbooks by the Klett Verlag (Klett Publishing) and will gain skills reading and writing in German.

Samstagsschule classes are organized by the German-Texan Heritage Society (GTHS), a non-profit organization dedicated to the preservation and promotion of the German heritage in Texas. Classes are held at GTHS headquarters (the historic German Free School) at 507 East 10th St.

Tuition for a 12-week semester (1 lesson per week) is \$150 per student for GTHS members and \$165 for non-members. Discounts are available for siblings. Class size is limited, so please register early. You can download a registration form at www.germantexans.org.
