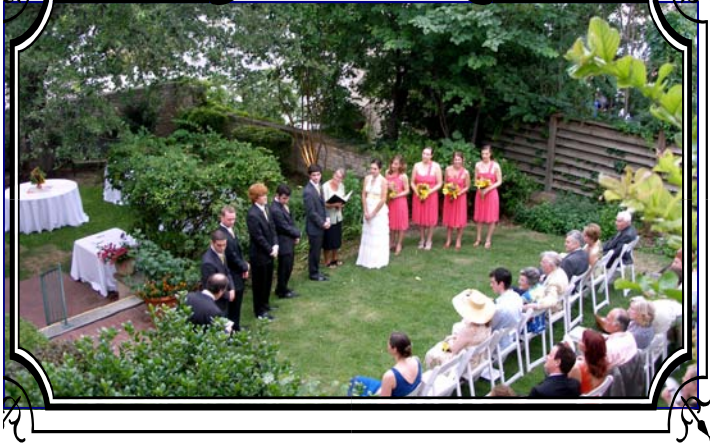


Your wedding day ... an historic event in an historic setting in downtown Austin

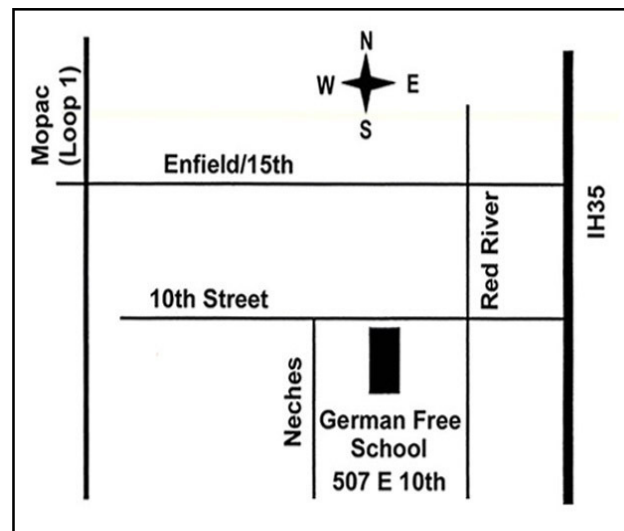
